Seed Grows of Itself




La Semilla que Crece por sí Sola

"This is how it is with the kingdom of God; it is as if a man were to scatter seed on the land and would sleep and rise night and day and the seed would sprout and grow, he knows not how."

Marcos 4, 26-27



11TH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME (Mc 4:26-34)

Evangelical phrase: "The seed germinates and grows" Preaching topic: THE GROWTH OF THE KINGDOM

- 1. The two parables of this gospel coincide in the importance of the seed, extremely active, but very small compared to the abundance of the final harvest. The kingdom of God grows slowly, "without knowing how."
- 2. The beginnings of the kingdom are slow and humble, in the midst of the silence of God. There are no extraordinary or miraculous signs here, but patient waiting, since, thanks to the Spirit, the seed has interior virtue and germination power. The means with which Jesus sows are humble; This is how ours should be. By aiming for quick and easy success, without accepting the slow and necessary process, we often witness resounding failures.
- 3. The end of the harvest is abundant. From time to time, during the harvest season, there is a feverish activity: what is sown produces its fruits; abundance is assured.

CHRISTIAN REFLECTION:

Do we have patience and hope or, on the contrary, are we quick to make negative judgments?

XI DOMINGO DEL TIEMPO ORDINARIO (Mc 4,26-34)

Frase evangélica: «La semilla germina y va creciendo» Tema de predicación: EL CRECIMIENTO DEL REINO

- 1. Las dos parábolas de este evangelio coinciden en la importancia de la semilla, sumamente activa, pero muy pequeña en comparación con la abundancia de la cosecha final. El reino de Dios crece lentamente, «sin saber cómo».
- 2. Los comienzos del reino son lentos y humildes, en medio del silencio de Dios. No aquí hay signos extraordinarios o milagrosos, sino espera paciente, ya que, gracias al Espíritu, la semilla tiene virtud interior y fuerza de germinación. Los medios con los que siembra Jesús son humildes; así deben ser los nuestros. Por pretender el triunfo fácil y rápido, sin aceptar el lento y necesario proceso, asistimos muchas veces a fracasos estrepitosos.
- 3. El final de la cosecha es abundante. De tiempo en tiempo, en época de siega, hay una febril actividad: lo sembrado produce sus frutos; la abundancia está asegurada.

How can you help the Kingdom of Heaven to grow in you? Going to Mass and receiving Holy Communion whenever you can, and going to Confession often are the


best ways. Praying every day and learning about the Faith and about the saints will also help the Kingdom of Heaven to grow in your heart like a strong, healthy plant!




